AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to work experience

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 336-c of the social services law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:

3 5. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, A SOCIAL 4 SERVICES OFFICIAL MAY NOT RECOVER PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PROPERLY PAID AS PERMITTED UNDER SECTIONS ONE HUNDRED FOUR, ONE HUNDRED FOUR-B, ONE 5 6 HUNDRED SIX, ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE-R AND SUBDIVISION THREE OF SECTION 7 HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT OF THIS CHAPTER OR ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ONE TITLE, WHERE A RECIPIENT OR FORMER RECIPIENT OF SUCH ASSISTANCE 8 WAS 9 REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN A WORK EXPERIENCE PROGRAM UNDER THIS SECTION, 10 WITHOUT FIRST CREDITING AGAINST SUCH RECOVERY THE NUMBER OF HOURS THAT SUCH PERSON ACTUALLY PARTICIPATED IN A WORK EXPERIENCE 11 PROGRAM MULTI-PLIED BY THE HIGHER OF THE APPLICABLE STATE OR FEDERAL MINIMUM WAGE. 12 13 Effective immediately, the office of temporary and disability S 2. 14 assistance shall promulgate rules and regulations, and conduct any requisite training necessary for the implementation of this act. 15 16 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
