- AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to the definition of income for purposes of the senior citizen rent increase exemptions (SCRIE) program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph c of subdivision 1 of section 467-b of the real 2 property tax law, as amended by chapter 500 of the laws of 2001, is 3 amended to read as follows:

4 income from all sources after deduction of all c. "Income" means 5 income and social security taxes and includes social security and supplemental security income and additional state 6 retirement benefits, 7 payments, public assistance benefits, interest, dividends, net rental income, salary or earnings, and net income from self-employment, but 8 9 shall not include gifts or inheritances, payments made to individuals 10 because of their status as victims of Nazi persecution, as defined in P.L. 103-286, or increases in benefits accorded pursuant to the social 11 security act or a public or private pension paid to any member of the 12 household which increase, in any given year, does not exceed the consum-er price index (all items United States city average) for such year 13 14 15 which take effect after the date of eligibility of head of the household receiving benefits hereunder whether received by the head of the house-16 hold or any other member of the household; PROVIDED HOWEVER THAT 17 INCOME

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SHALL NOT INCLUDE INCOME FROM SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS OR SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY INCOME PAYMENTS IF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MUNICIPALITY IN WHICH THE SENIOR CITIZEN RESIDES, AFTER PUBLIC HEARING, ADOPTS A LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE, OR RESOLUTION ELECTING TO EXEMPT SUCH BENEFITS AND PAYMENTS;

6 S 2. Paragraph f of subdivision 1 of section 467-c of the real proper-7 ty tax law, as amended by chapter 500 of the laws of 2001, is amended to 8 read as follows:

9 f. "Income" means income received by the eligible head of the house-10 hold combined with the income of all other members of the household from all sources after deduction of all income and social security taxes and 11 includes without limitation, social security and retirement benefits, 12 13 supplemental security income and additional state payments, public 14 assistance benefits, interest, dividends, net rental income, salary and 15 earnings, and net income from self employment, but shall not include gifts or inheritances, payments made to individuals because of their 16 status as victims of Nazi persecution as defined in P.L. 103-286, nor 17 18 increases in benefits accorded pursuant to the social security act or a 19 public or private pension paid to any member of the household which increase, in any given year, does not exceed the consumer price index 20 21 (all items United States city average) for such year which take effect 22 after the eligibility date of an eligible head of the household receiving benefits hereunder whether received by the eligible head of the household or any other member of the household. When the eligible head 23 24 25 of the household has retired on or after the commencement of the taxable 26 period and prior to the date of making an application for a rent increase exemption order/tax abatement certificate pursuant to this 27 such person's income shall be adjusted by excluding salary or 28 section, 29 earnings and projecting such person's retirement income over the entire FOR PURPOSES OF DETERMINING INCOME PURSUANT TO THIS 30 taxable period. PARAGRAPH, INCOME SHALL NOT INCLUDE SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS AND SUPPLE-31 32 MENTAL SECURITY INCOME PAYMENTS IF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE LOCAL 33 MUNICIPALITY IN WHICH THE SENIOR CITIZEN RESIDES, AFTER PUBLIC HEARING, 34 ADOPTS A LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE, OR RESOLUTION ELECTING TO EXEMPT SUCH 35 BENEFITS AND PAYMENTS.

36 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that 37 the amendments to paragraph c of subdivision 1 of section 467-b of the 38 real property tax law, made by section one of this act, shall not affect 39 the expiration of such section and shall be deemed to expire therewith.
