AN ACT to amend the banking law, in relation to ensuring that account
numbers are not printed on receipts from banks

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The banking law is amended by adding a new section 9-v to
2 read as follows:
3 S 9-V. BANK RECEIPTS; PRINTING OF COMPLETE ACCOUNT NUMBERS PROHIBITED.
4 1. NO BANK, CREDIT UNION, TRUST COMPANY, SAVINGS BANK, OR STATE OR
5 FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION HAVING AS ITS PURPOSE OR AMONG ITS
6 PURPOSES THE CONDUCTING OF FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS WITH CUSTOMERS,
7 INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO WITHDRAWALS AND DEPOSITS, SHALL PRINT UPON
8 ANY RECEIPT PROVIDED TO THE CUSTOMER MORE THAN THE LAST FIVE DIGITS OF
9 ANY BANK ACCOUNT OR MORE THAN THE LAST FIVE DIGITS OF THE CHARGE, CREDIT
10 OR DEBIT CARD ACCOUNT NUMBER USED IN A TRANSACTION.
11 2. THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY ONLY TO RECEIPTS THAT ARE ELECTRONICALLY
12 PRINTED AND SHALL NOT APPLY TO TRANSACTIONS IN WHICH THE SOLE MEANS OF
13 RECORDING THE CUSTOMER'S ACCOUNT NUMBER IS BY HANDWRITING.
14 3. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY TO ALL BANK MACHINES OR
15 OTHER DEVICES WHICH ELECTRONICALLY PRINT RECEIPTS FOR FINANCIAL TRANS-
16 ACTIONS, INCLUDING AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINES AS DEFINED IN SECTION
17 SEVENTY-FIVE-B OF THIS CHAPTER, THAT ARE PLACED IN SERVICE ON OR AFTER
18 JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TEN.
19 4. FOR ALL BANK MACHINES OR OTHER DEVICES THAT ELECTRONICALLY PRINT
20 RECEIPTS FOR FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS IN SERVICE PRIOR TO JANUARY FIRST,
21 TWO THOUSAND TEN, THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY UNTIL
22 JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN.
23 5. A BANK, CREDIT UNION, TRUST COMPANY, SAVINGS BANK, OR STATE OR
24 FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION SHALL BE

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1 GIVEN NOTICE WITH SPECIFICITY OF SUCH VIOLATION AND BE GRANTED TWO WEEKS
2 TO CORRECT SUCH VIOLATION IN ITS ENTIRETY. IF SUCH VIOLATION IS NOT
3 CORRECTED IN ITS ENTIRETY AT THE END OF SUCH TWO-WEEK PERIOD, THE
4 VIOLATION SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A CIVIL PENALTY OF FIVE HUNDRED
5 DOLLARS, AND THE VIOLATOR SHALL BE GRANTED AN ADDITIONAL ONE WEEK IN
6 WHICH TO CORRECT SUCH VIOLATION IN ITS ENTIRETY. IF SUCH VIOLATION IS
7 NOT CORRECTED IN ITS ENTIRETY AT THE END OF SUCH ONE-WEEK PERIOD, SUCH
8 VIOLATION SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A CIVIL PENALTY OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS
9 PER WEEK UNTIL SUCH VIOLATION IS CORRECTED IN ITS ENTIRETY. THE AGGRE-
10 GATE PENALTIES IMPOSED ON A BANK, CREDIT UNION, TRUST COMPANY, SAVINGS
11 BANK, OR STATE OR FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION FOR VIOLATIONS OF
12 THIS SECTION SHALL NOT EXCEED FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR
13 VIOLATIONS OCCURRING ON THE SAME PREMISES.

14 S 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2010.
