THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The legislative law is amended by adding a new article 5-C to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5-C

LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE

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SECTION 88-K. NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE. 88-L. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE.

- NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE. THERE IS HEREBY CREATED A NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE.
- 10 S 88-L. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE 1. THENON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL PERFORM BUDGET ANALYSIS TO DETERMINE THE FUNDING LEVELS NECESSARY TO THE GOVERNMENTAL DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS AND RENDER ANTICIPATED REVENUE ESTIMATES FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR. SUCH REVENUE ESTIMATES SHALL BE USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR PURPOSES OF DETERMINING BUDGET EXPENDITURES.
 - THE DIRECTOR OF THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL EXAMINE AND REVIEW ALL FINANCIAL INFORMATION OF THE STATE RENDERING REVENUE ESTIMATES USED IN DETERMINING WHETHER THE PURPOSE OF PROPOSED STATE BUDGET IS BALANCED.
- 3. THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL BE 20 HEADED BY A 21 WHO SHALL BE APPOINTED BY A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND DIRECTOR 22 ASSEMBLY FOR A TERM OF FIVE YEARS. HE OR SHE SHALL DEVOTE HIS 23 TIME AND EFFORT TO THE OFFICE OF DIRECTOR AND HE OR SHE SHALL HOLD

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [] is old law to be omitted.

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NO OTHER PUBLIC OFFICE. THE DIRECTOR SHALL RECEIVE SUCH COMPENSATION AS MAY BE FIXED BY THE OFFICE. THE DIRECTOR MAY APPOINT BUDGET ANALYSTS, ASSISTANTS AND SUCH OTHER EMPLOYEES AS HE OR SHE MAY DEEM NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE, PRESCRIBE THEIR DUTIES AND FIX THEIR COMPENSATION WITHIN THE AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED AND MADE AVAILABLE THEREFOR.

- 4. THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL BE CHARGED WITH THE DUTY OF RENDERING ANTICIPATED REVENUE FORECAST REPORTS TO THE LEGISLATURE AND THE GOVERNOR FOR THE PURPOSES OF FACILITATING PASSAGE OF THE STATE BUDGET IN A TIMELY MANNER. THE DIRECTOR MAY REQUEST AND SHALL RECEIVE FROM ALL PUBLIC OFFICERS, DEPARTMENTS, AGENCIES AND AUTHORITIES OF THE STATE AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS, SUCH ASSISTANCE AND DATA AS SHALL BE NECESSARY TO PROJECT ANTICIPATED STATE REVENUES FOR BUDGETARY PURPOSES.
- 5. THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL PROVIDE ASSISTANCE IN DETERMINING THE FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION.
- 16 6. THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL SUBMIT TO THE 17 STATE LEGISLATURE WRITTEN ESTIMATES OF ANTICIPATED STATE REVENUES ON 18 JANUARY FIFTEENTH, APRIL FIFTEENTH, JULY FIFTEENTH AND OCTOBER FIFTEENTH 19 OF EACH YEAR.
- 20 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
