AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to a fine for  
parked or unattended semitrailers or trailers on streets of a city  
with a population of one million or more

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Paragraph 2 of subdivision (b) of section 1204 of the vehi-  
2     cle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 193 of the laws of 1974, is  
3     amended to read as follows:  
4     2. In any city with a population of one million or more, whenever any  
5     police officer, or any person designated by the commissioner of traffic,  
6     finds a semitrailer or trailer without a tractor or towing vehicle  
7     attached, parked or unattended on any city street, such officer or  
8     person designated by the commissioner of traffic is hereby authorized to  
9     provide for the removal of such semitrailer or trailer to a garage,  
10    automobile pound or other place of safety. THE OWNER OR OTHER PERSON  
11    LAWFULLY ENTITLED TO THE POSSESSION OF SUCH SEMITRAILER OR TRAILER SHALL  
12    BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS.  
13    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
