AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to penalties for the operation of vehicles on approach of authorized emergency vehicles

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (e) of section 1800 of the vehicle and traffic
2 law, as amended by section 1 of part C of chapter 62 of the laws of
3 2003, is amended to read as follows:
4 (e) Every person convicted of a violation of the provisions of section
5 eleven hundred forty-four of this chapter shall for a first conviction
6 thereof be punished by a fine of not LESS THAN ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS NOR
7 more than two hundred seventy-five dollars or by imprisonment for not
8 more than fifteen days or by both such fine and imprisonment. For a
9 conviction of a second violation, both of which were committed within a
10 period of eighteen months, such person shall be punished by a fine of
11 not LESS THAN TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS NOR more than four hundred fifty
12 dollars or by imprisonment for not more than forty-five days or by both
13 such fine and imprisonment. For a conviction of a third violation and
14 all subsequent violations, all of which were committed within a period
15 of eighteen months, such person shall be punished by a fine of not LESS
16 THAN THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS NOR more than seven hundred fifty dollars or
17 by imprisonment for not more than ninety days or by both such fine and
18 imprisonment.
19 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
20 have become a law.
