Introduced by M. of A. JOHN, NOLAN -- read once and referred to the Committee on Labor -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to developing and implementing programs to prevent workplace violence in public schools

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 27-b of the labor
2 law, as added by chapter 82 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as
3 follows:
4 a. "Employer" means: (1) the state; (2) a political subdivision of the
5 state[, provided, however that this subdivision shall not mean any
6 employer as defined in section twenty-eight hundred one-a of the educa-
7 tion law]; and (3) a public authority, a public benefit corporation, or
8 any other governmental agency or instrumentality thereof.
9 S 2. The provisions of this act shall not diminish the rights of
10 employees pursuant to any law, rule, regulation or collective bargaining
11 agreement.
12 S 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after
13 it shall have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediate-
14 ly, the addition, amendment, and/or repeal of any rule, regulation or
15 guideline necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective
16 date is authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before
17 such date.
