AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to increas-
ing funds available for the purpose of spaying, neutering and animal
cruelty prevention

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 110 of the agriculture and markets
2 law, as amended by chapter 86 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as
3 follows:
4 1. The license fee for each dog license issued pursuant to subdivision
5 one of section one hundred nine of this article shall be:
6 (a) [two] THREE dollars and fifty cents for each spayed or neutered
7 dog and [seven] EIGHT dollars and fifty cents for each unspayed or
8 unneutered dog licensed for one year;
9 (b) [five] SEVEN dollars for each spayed or neutered dog and [fifteen]
10 SEVENTEEN dollars for each unspayed or unneutered dog licensed for two
11 years;
12 (c) [seven] TEN dollars and fifty cents for each spayed or neutered
13 dog and [twenty-two] TWENTY-FIVE dollars and fifty cents for each
14 unspayed or unneutered dog licensed for three years.
15 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
16 have become a law and shall apply to dog licenses issued on or after
17 such effective date.
