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Introduced by M. of A. V. LOPEZ -- read once and referred to the Committee on Insurance

AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to prohibiting insurance rate variations of more than ten percent between counties within the city of New York for non-business private passenger automobiles

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 2307 of the insurance law is  
2     amended to read as follows:  
3     (a) (1) No insurer or rate service organization shall use a rating  
4     classification or territory unless it has been filed with the super-  
5     intendent and either he OR SHE has approved it, or ninety days have  
6     elapsed and he OR SHE has not disapproved it as unfairly discriminatory  
7     or violative of public policy.  
8     (2) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, WITH RESPECT TO  
9     NON-BUSINESS PRIVATE PASSENGER AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE POLICIES, NO INSURER  
10    OR RATE SERVICE ORGANIZATION SHALL USE, APPLY FOR OR FILE WITH THE  
11    SUPERINTENDENT FOR APPROVAL ANY RATES THAT APPLY TO RATING TERRITORIES  
12    WITHIN THE CITY OF NEW YORK THAT PROVIDE FOR RATE VARIATIONS BETWEEN ANY  
13    COUNTY WITHIN THE CITY OF NEW YORK OF MORE THAN TEN PERCENT.  
14    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to all  
15    policies of insurance altered, amended, issued or renewed on or after  
16    such effective date.
