AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring oil companies to clean up spillage occurring during a delivery

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 309 to read as follows:
- 309. OIL DELIVERY SPILLAGE. ANY SPILLAGE OCCURRING IN THE COURSE OF OIL DELIVERY SHALL BE CLEANED UP BY THEOIL DELIVERY COMPANY IF THE SPILL AFFECTS SOIL THE CLEAN UP SHALL INCLUDE 5 TWENTY-FOUR HOURS. 6 THEAFFECTED SOIL WITH NEW SOIL. VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION REPLACING 7 SHALL RESULT IN A FINE OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE AND 8 ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR EACH ADDITIONAL OFFENSE, NOT TO EXCEED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS PAYABLE BY THE OIL DELIVERY COMPANY. 9
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 11 have become a law.
