AN ACT to amend the economic development law, in relation to creating the Empire State Fishing Trail program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The economic development law is amended by adding a new article 5-F to read as follows:

181-G. DEFINITION.

181-H. GENERAL FUNCTIONS, POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMISSIONER. 181-F. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. NEW YORK STATE IS HOME TO MANY WATER RESOURCES INCLUDING HUNDREDS OF MILES OF ATLANTIC OCEAN COASTLINE, THOUSANDS OF MILES OF RIVERS AND STREAMS, THOUSANDS OF LAKES AND PONDS, AND MILLIONS OF ACRES OF WETLANDS. THE FISHING OPPORTUNITIES UNIQUE RANGING FROM SALT WATER TO FRESH WATER. THE STATE HAS AND CONSISTENTLY BEEN RECOGNIZED FOR ITS OUTSTANDING FISHERIES AND HAS RATED NUMBER ONE FOR BASS FISHING IN THE COUNTRY. ACCORDING TO THE AMER-SPORTFISHING ASSOCIATION, ANGLERS SPEND MORE THAN 1.1 BILLION DOLLARS ON FISHING TRIPS, EQUIPMENT AND LICENSES, WHICH SUPPORT SEVENTEEN THOUSAND JOBS THROUGHOUT NEW YORK. FISHING TOURNA-EXCESS OF MENTS HAVE RISEN IN POPULARITY AND THIS STATE HAS REGULARLY NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL TOURNAMENTS WHICH BRING WORLDWIDE TO ATTENTION. AS SUCH, THE STATE HAS AN EXCELLENT OPPORTUNITY TO

- 3 S 181-G. DEFINITION. AS USED IN THIS ARTICLE, "FISHING TRAIL" SHALL 4 MEAN A SERIES OF FISHERIES IN THE STATE IDENTIFIED BY THE COMMISSIONER, 5 WHICH MAY BE LINKED BY GEOGRAPHY, QUALITY AND/OR EVENTS.
- S 181-H. GENERAL FUNCTIONS, POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMISSIONER. THE COMMISSIONER, IN COOPERATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION, THE COMMISSIONER OF PARKS, RECREATION AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION, AND ANY LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL OR ENTITY, SHALL EXPAND UPON
