AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to use of school facilities by not-for-profit organizations for after-school programs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 27 of section 2590-h of the education law, as
2 amended by chapter 720 of the laws of 1996, is amended to read as
3 follows:
4 27. Develop, in conjunction with each community superintendent, a plan
5 for providing access to school facilities in each community school
6 district, when not in use for school purposes, in accordance with the
7 provisions of section four hundred fourteen of this chapter. Such plan
8 shall set forth a reasonable system of fees not to exceed the actual
9 costs and specify that no part of any fee shall directly or indirectly
10 benefit or be deposited into an account which inures to the benefit of
11 the custodians or custodial engineers. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW,
12 RULE OR REGULATION TO THE CONTRARY, SUCH PLAN MAY PROVIDE THAT NO FEE
13 WILL BE CHARGED FOR USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES BY A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGAN-
14 IZATION TO CONDUCT AN AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM OF AN EDUCATIONAL PURPOSE.
15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
