AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to loitering

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 7 of section 240.35 of the penal law, as
2 amended by chapter 395 of the laws of 2001, is amended and a new subdi-
3 vision 8 is added to read as follows:
4 7. Loiters or remains in any transportation facility, or is found
5 sleeping therein, and is unable to give a satisfactory explanation of
6 his presence[.]; OR
7 8. LOITERS OR REMAINS IN ANY TRANSPORTATION FACILITY, WITHIN
8 TWENTY-FIVE FEET OF THE TOKEN BOOTH OR SIMILAR LOCATION, FOR MORE THAN
9 TWENTY-FIVE MINUTES, UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED TO DO SO, UNLESS
10 BECAUSE OF THE FACILITY'S SIZE OR DESIGN IT WOULD BE IMPOSSIBLE TO MAIN-
11 TAIN SUCH DISTANCE.
12 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day next succeeding
13 the date on which it shall have become a law.
