Introduced by M. of A. BOYLAND -- read once and referred to the Committee on Correction

AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to requiring officials in corrections facilities to provide information to and instruct and assist certain prisoners in applications for Medicaid

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 618 of the correction law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:
- 4. OFFICIALS OF CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS SHALL PROVIDE INFORMATION INSTRUCTION TO AND SHALL ASSIST PRISONERS WHO WILL BE RELEASED FROM THE CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN PREPARING AND APPLYING FOR THEINSURANCE PROGRAM KNOWN AS MEDICAID. SUCH OFFICIALS SHALL NOTIFY ALL 7 SUCH PRISONERS, AT LEAST NINETY DAYS PRIOR TO THEIR RELEASE 8 INSTITUTION, OF THE MEDICAID PROGRAM, HOW TO APPLY TO RECEIVE MEDICAID SO THAT THEY MAY RECEIVE IT AFTER THEIR RELEASE FROM THE INSTITUTION AND 9 HOW TO RECEIVE ASSISTANCE AT THE CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION TO APPLY FOR 10
- 11 MEDICAID.
- 12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
