AN ACT to amend the business corporation law, the limited liability company law and the partnership law, in relation to authorizing certain health care providers to form professional service entities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of section 1503 of the business corporation 2 law, as added by chapter 974 of the laws of 1970, is amended to read as 3 follows:

4 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, one or more individ-5 uals duly authorized by law to render the same professional service 6 within the state may organize, or cause to be organized, a professional 7 service corporation for pecuniary profit under this article for the 8 purpose of rendering the same professional service, [except] PROVIDED that one or more individuals duly authorized by law to practice profes-9 sional engineering, architecture, landscape architecture or land survey-10 ing within the state may organize, or cause to be organized, a profes-11 12 sional service corporation for pecuniary profit under this article for the purpose of rendering such professional services as such individuals 13 authorized to practice, AND, FURTHER, PROVIDED THAT ONE OR MORE 14 are INDIVIDUALS DULY LICENSED BY LAW TO PRACTICE MEDICINE AND WHO ARE CERTI-15 16 FIED BY THE AMERICAN BOARD OF OPHTHALMOLOGY, AND INDIVIDUALS LICENSED BY 17 LAW TO PRACTICE OPTOMETRY AND/OR OPHTHALMIC DISPENSING WITHIN THE STATE 18 MAY ORGANIZE, OR CAUSE TO BE ORGANIZED, A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CORPO-RATION FOR PECUNIARY PROFIT UNDER THIS ARTICLE FOR 19 THE PURPOSE OF RENDERING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AS SUCH INDIVIDUALS ARE AUTHORIZED TO 20 21 PRACTICE.

S 2. Section 1529 of the business corporation law, as amended by chapter 576 of the laws of 1994, is amended to read as follows: S 1529. Business corporation law applicable.

Except for the provisions of sections thirteen hundred three, thirteen 1 2 hundred four, thirteen hundred sixteen, thirteen hundred seventeen and 3 thirteen hundred twenty, this chapter shall be applicable to a foreign 4 professional service corporation to the extent that the provisions ther-5 are not in conflict with the provisions of this article. A foreign eof 6 professional service corporation may practice in this state, or may 7 consolidate or merge with another corporation, or may be a member of a 8 professional service limited liability company, a foreign professional service limited liability company, a registered limited liability part-9 10 nership or foreign limited liability partnership, only if all of the 11 professions practiced by such corporations, limited liability companies 12 or limited liability partnerships could be practiced by a single professional service corporation organized in this state; and, further, only 13 14 if such foreign professional service corporation is domiciled in a state 15 or territory of the United States the laws of which, at the time of 16 application by such corporation under section fifteen hundred thirty of 17 this article, contain a reciprocal provision under which professional 18 service corporations domiciled in this state may similarly apply for the 19 privilege of doing business in any such state or territory[; provided 20 further however, that nothing herein].

NOTHING IN THIS SECTION shall authorize a foreign professional 21 (A) 22 service corporation practicing professional engineering, land surveying, 23 architecture and/or landscape architecture to be a member or partner of a professional service limited liability company, a foreign professional 24 25 service limited liability company, a registered limited liability part-26 nership or a foreign limited liability partnership unless all of the shareholders, directors and officers of such foreign professional 27 service corporation are licensed to practice one or more of 28 such 29 professions in this state.

IN THIS SECTION SHALL AUTHORIZE A FOREIGN PROFESSIONAL 30 NOTHING (B) 31 SERVICE CORPORATION ORGANIZED TO PRACTICE MEDICINE WITH OPTOMETRY AND/OR 32 OPHTHALMIC DISPENSING TO BE A MEMBER OR PARTNER А OF PROFESSIONAL 33 SERVICE LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY, A FOREIGN PROFESSIONAL SERVICE LIMIT-34 ED LIABILITY COMPANY, A REGISTERED LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIP OR A 35 FOREIGN LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIP UNLESS ALL OF THE SHAREHOLDERS, DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS OF SUCH FOREIGN PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CORPORATION 36 37 ARE LICENSED TO PRACTICE ONE OR MORE OF SUCH PROFESSIONS IN THIS STATE; 38 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT ANY SHAREHOLDER, DIRECTOR OR OFFICER LICENSED TO PRACTICE MEDICINE IN THIS STATE SHALL ALSO BE CERTIFIED BY THE AMERICAN 39 40 BOARD OF OPHTHALMOLOGY.

S 3. Subdivision (a) of section 1203 of the limited liability company law, as separately amended by chapters 420 and 676 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read as follows:

44 (a) Notwithstanding the education law or any other provision of law, 45 or more professionals each of whom is authorized by law to render a one 46 professional service within the state, or one or more professionals, at 47 least one of whom is authorized by law to render a professional service 48 within the state, may form, or cause to be formed, a professional 49 service limited liability company for pecuniary profit under this arti-50 cle for the purpose of rendering the professional service or services as 51 such professionals are authorized to practice. With respect to a professional service limited liability company formed to provide medical 52 53 services as such services are defined in article 131 of the education 54 law, each member of such limited liability company must be licensed 55 article 131 of the education law to practice medicine in pursuant to this state; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT 56 WITH RESPECT TO A PROFESSIONAL 1

Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a professional service limited liability 52 company (i) authorized to practice law may only engage in another 53 54 profession or business or activities or (ii) which is engaged in a 55 profession or other business or activities other than law may only engage in the practice of law, to the extent not prohibited by any other 56

1 law of this state or any rule adopted by the appropriate appellate divi-2 sion of the supreme court or the court of appeals.
