amend the public health law, in relation to prohibiting AN ACT to certain restaurants and food establishments from serving containing artificial trans fat; and providing for the repeal of certain provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

The public health law is amended by adding a new section 1 Section 1. 1352-d to read as follows:

- S 1352-D. ARTIFICIAL TRANS FAT; PROHIBITION. 1. NO FOOD CONTAINING TRANS FAT, AS DEFINED IN THIS SECTION, SHALL BE STORED, ARTIFICIAL DISTRIBUTED, HELD FOR SERVICE, USED IN PREPARATION OF ANY MENU ITEM, SERVED OR SOLD IN ANY RESTAURANTS, FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS, MOBILE FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT COMMISSARIES, RETAIL FOOD STORES AS DEFINED SECTION FIVE HUNDRED OF THE AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS LAW, AND OTHER FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS, SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION THIRTEEN 10 HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE OF THIS TITLE, EXCEPT FOOD THAT IS SERVED OR SOLD DIRECTLY TO PATRONS IN A MANUFACTURER'S ORIGINAL SEALED PACKAGE.
 - 2. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A FOOD SHALL BE DEEMED TO CONTAIN ARTIFICIAL TRANS FAT IF THE FOOD IS LABELED AS, LISTS AS AN INGREDIENT, CONTAINS VEGETABLE SHORTENING, MARGARINE OR ANY KIND OF PARTIALLY HYDROGENATED VEGETABLE OIL. HOWEVER, A FOOD WHOSE NUTRITION FACTS OR OTHER DOCUMENTATION FROM THE MANUFACTURER LISTS THE TRANS FAT CONTENT THE FOOD AS LESS THAN 0.5 GRAMS PER SERVING, SHALL NOT BE DEEMED TO CONTAIN ARTIFICIAL TRANS FAT. THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY CONTAINING ONLY NATURALLY OCCURRING TRANS FAT.
- 20 COMMISSIONER IS AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PROMULGATE RULES 21 AND REGULATIONS FOR RECORDKEEPING AND DOCUMENTATION BY RESTAURANTS

FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION NECESSARY FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL CONSULT WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF RESTAURANTS AND FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS, ANY MUNICIPAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS THAT HAVE SIMILAR LAWS OR REGULATIONS AND 5 THE COMMISSIONER OF AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS, PRIOR TO PROMULGATING ANY 6 SUCH RULES OR REGULATIONS AND, TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PRACTICABLE, INCOR-7 SIMILAR RULES AND REGULATIONS ALREADY ADOPTED BY OTHER GOVERN-8 MENTS. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DEVELOP GUIDELINES, INCLUDING RECOMMENDA-9 FOR HEALTHIER ALTERNATIVES TO ARTIFICIAL TRANS FAT AND 10 IDENTIFICATION OF PRODUCTS AND SUPPLIERS OF SUCH ALTERNATIVES, TO ASSIST RESTAURANTS AND FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS IN COMPLYING WITH THE PROVISIONS 11 THIS SECTION. SUCH GUIDELINES SHALL BE MADE READILY AVAILABLE TO RESTAU-12 RANTS AND FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS AND SHALL BE PROVIDED ON THE DEPARTMENT'S 13 14 INTERNET WEBSITE.

- 4. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION THIRTEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE OF THIS TITLE, THE PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE PENALTY SET FORTH IN SECTION TWELVE OF THIS CHAPTER.
- 5. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL RESTRICT THE POWER OF ANY COUNTY, CITY, TOWN OR VILLAGE TO ADOPT AND ENFORCE ADDITIONAL LOCAL LAWS, ORDINANCES OR REGULATIONS THAT ARE MORE STRINGENT THAN THE STANDARDS SET FORTH IN THIS SECTION AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED PURSUANT THERETO, EXCEPT THAT ANY LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE OR REGULATION RESTRICTING ARTIFICIAL TRANS FAT ADOPTED BY ANY COUNTY OR CITY, OR DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY THEREOF, OR TOWN OR VILLAGE PRIOR TO THE DATE THIS SECTION SHALL HAVE BECOME A LAW SHALL NOT BE PREEMPTED BY THIS SECTION.
- 6. THIS SECTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TEN WITH RESPECT TO OILS, SHORTENINGS AND MARGARINES CONTAINING ARTIFICIAL TRANS FAT, AND SHALL TAKE EFFECT JUNE FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN WITH RESPECT TO ALL OTHER FOODS CONTAINING ARTIFICIAL TRANS FAT.
- 31 S 2. This act shall take effect December 31, 2010, provided, that
 32 effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule
 33 or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effec34 tive date is authorized to be made and completed on or before such
 35 date; and provided, further, that subdivision 5 of section 1352-d of the
 36 public health law, as added by section one of this act, shall expire and
 37 be deemed repealed December 31, 2021.
