## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY

proposing an amendment to article 7 of the constitution, in relation to restricting the use of fees and taxes paid into a dedicated highway and bridge trust fund and a dedicated mass transportation trust fund

Section 1. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That article 7 of the constitution be amended by adding two new sections 20 and 21 to read as follows:

ACT; PAYMENTS

MONEYS IN 20. THE DEDICATED HIGHWAY AND BRIDGE TRUST FUND ESTAB-LISHED BY LAW SHALL BE SEPARATELY KEPT AND SAFELY INVESTED AND SHALL NOT 5 BE APPROPRIATED OR USED IN ANY MANNER OTHER THAN FOR RECONSTRUCTION, 7 REPLACEMENT, RECONDITIONING, RESTORATION, REHABILITATION, AND PRESERVA-TION OF HIGHWAYS, PARKWAYS AND BRIDGES THEREON, TO RESTORE SUCH FACILI-TIES TO THEIR INTENDED FUNCTIONS; CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, ENHANCE-9 10 IMPROVEMENT OF HIGHWAYS, PARKWAYS AND BRIDGES THEREON, TO AND 11 ADDRESS CURRENT AND PROJECTED CAPACITY PROBLEMS; MATCHING FEDERAL GRANTS 12 OR APPORTIONMENTS TO THE STATE FOR HIGHWAY, PARKWAY AND BRIDGE CAPITAL THE ACOUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY AND INTERESTS 13 THEREIN REQUIRED OR EXPECTED TO BE REQUIRED IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH PROJECTS; 14 15 PAYMENTS PURSUANT TO ANY AGREEMENT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW, WITH PRIVATE ARCHITECTS, LAND SURVEYORS OR OTHERS PRACTICING SUCH 16 ENGINEERS, 17 PROFESSIONS, TO FACILITATE SUCH PROJECTS; PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE ACTIV-ITIES NECESSARY TO ENSURE THAT HIGHWAYS, PARKWAYS AND BRIDGES MEET OR 18 EXCEED THEIR OPTIMUM USEFUL LIFE; EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE 19 DEVELOP-MENT OR CONSTRUCTION OF SUCH PROJECTS UP TO THE AMOUNT HISTORICALLY 20 21 APPROPRIATED FROM THE ENGINEERING SERVICES FUND FROM STATE EXCEPT SUCH AMOUNTS THAT ARE REIMBURSED FROM THE PROCEEDS OF THE ACCEL-ERATED CAPACITY AND TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS OF THE 23 NINETIES BOND

AMOUNTS REQUIRED FOR SERVICE CONTRACT PAYMENTS AS PROVIDED AND AUTHORZIZED BY LAW TO SUPPORT THE CONSOLIDATED LOCAL HIGHWAY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
AND THE NON-FEDERAL SHARE OF FEDERAL AID MUNICIPAL STREET AND HIGHWAY
PROJECTS; THE PAYMENT OF DEBT SERVICE REQUIRED ON ANY BONDS, NOTES OR
OTHER OBLIGATIONS FOR HIGHWAY, PARKWAY AND BRIDGE PURPOSES AUTHORIZED ON
OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE DEDICATED HIGHWAY AND BRIDGE TRUST
FUND; AND SUCH OTHER HIGHWAY, PARKWAY AND BRIDGE PURPOSES AS MAY BE
AUTHORIZED BY THE LEGISLATURE PURSUANT TO LAW.

- S 21. MONEYS IN THE DEDICATED MASS TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED BY LAW SHALL BE SEPARATELY KEPT AND SAFELY INVESTED AND SHALL NOT BE APPROPRIATED OR USED IN ANY MANNER OTHER THAN FOR RECONSTRUCTION, REPLACEMENT, PURCHASE, MODERNIZATION, IMPROVEMENT, RECONDITIONING, PRESERVATION AND MAINTENANCE OF MASS TRANSIT FACILITIES, VEHICLES AND ROLLING STOCK OR THE PAYMENT OF DEBT SERVICE OR OPERATING EXPENSES INCURRED BY MASS TRANSIT OPERATING AGENCIES.
- S 2. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That the foregoing amendments be referred to the first regular legislative session convening after the next succeeding general election of members of the assembly, and, in conformity with section 1 of article 19 of the constitution, be published for 3 months previous to the time of such election.
