AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to reporting convictions of illegal aliens

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 265.30 of the penal law is amended to read as follows:
- S 265.30 Certain convictions to be reported.
- Every conviction under this article or section 400.00, of a person who 5 is not a citizen of the United States, shall be certified to the proper officer of the United States government by the district attorney of the 7 county in which such conviction was had. ALSO EVERY CONVICTION UNDER THIS CHAPTER OF A PERSON WHO IS DETERMINED TO BE AN ILLEGAL ALIEN SHALL 9 BE CERTIFIED TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY BY THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH SUCH CONVICTION WAS HAD WITH 10
- THE RECOMMENDATION THAT ACTION BE TAKEN TO DEPORT SUCH PERSON. 11
- S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-12 ing the date on which it shall have become a law. 13
