AN ACT to amend the New York state urban development corporation act, in relation to the establishment of an African-American and African-Caribbean business development center

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 174 of the laws of 1968, constituting the New York state urban development corporation act, is amended by adding a new section 9-g to read as follows:
- CREATING AN AFRICAN-AMERICAN AND AFRICAN-CARIBBEAN BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTER. THE CORPORATION SHALL PROVIDE, WITH THE ASSISTANCE THE COMMISSIONER OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND IN CONSULTATION WITH 7 SUCH COMMISSIONER, AN AFRICAN-AMERICAN AND AFRICAN-CARIBBEAN BUSINESS 8 DEVELOPMENT CENTER FOR THE PURPOSES OF RENDERING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO NOT-FOR-PROFIT SERVICE 9 AND MARKET INFORMATION PROVIDERS AND 10 SERVICING AFRICAN-AMERICAN AND AFRICAN-CARIBBEAN PRIVATE BUSINESSES COMMUNITIES. 11
- 12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
