AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to providing a tax credit for the purchase of items relating to firearm safety

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 606 of the tax law is amended by adding a new 2 subsection (qq) to read as follows:

3 (OO) A TAXPAYER SHALL BE ALLOWED A CREDIT AS HEREINAFTER PROVIDED, AGAINST THE TAX IMPOSED BY THIS ARTICLE FOR THE PURCHASE, OTHER THAN FOR 4 5 RESALE, OF GUN SAFES OR VAULTS, FIREARM SAFETY LOCKS, TRIGGER LOCKS OR 6 OTHER ITEMS DESIGNED ΤO ENSURE THE SAFE HANDLING AND STORAGE OF 7 FIREARMS. THE AMOUNT OF CREDIT SHALL BE EQUAL TO TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT OF THE TAXPAYER OF THE PURCHASE OF SUCH FIREARM SAFETY ITEMS THE 8 COST OF 9 DURING THE TAXABLE YEAR, SUCH CREDIT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS 10 PER YEAR.

11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to taxable 12 years beginning on and after January 1, 2009.
