AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to the residence of a sex offender

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 168-c of the correction law is amended by adding a new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:
- 2-A. NO SEX OFFENDER RELEASED OR DISCHARGED FROM A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, HOSPITAL OR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY OR PLACED ON PROBATION SHALL RESIDE WITHIN FIVE HUNDRED FEET OF A BUILDING USED EXCLUSIVELY AS A SCHOOL, THE MEASUREMENTS TO BE TAKEN IN STRAIGHT LINES FROM THE CENTER OF THE NEAREST ENTRANCE OF THE RESIDENCE TO THE CENTER OF THE NEAREST ENTRANCE OF SUCH SCHOOL.
- 9 S 2. Section 168-f of the correction law is amended by adding a new 10 subdivision 4-a to read as follows:

- 4-A. A SEX OFFENDER, AFTER HIS OR HER DISCHARGE, PAROLE OR RELEASE FROM ANY CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, HOSPITAL OR LOCAL FACILITY OR WHO WAS PLACED ON PROBATION AND WHO HAS ESTABLISHED A RESIDENCE SHALL NOT CHANGE SAID RESIDENCE SO AS TO RESIDE WITHIN FIVE HUNDRED FEET OF A BUILDING USED EXCLUSIVELY AS A SCHOOL, THE MEASUREMENTS TO BE TAKEN IN STRAIGHT LINES FROM THE CENTER OF THE NEAREST ENTRANCE OF THE RESIDENCE TO THE CENTER OF THE NEAREST ENTRANCE OF THE RESIDENCE TO THE
- 18 S 3. Section 168-k of the correction law is amended by adding a new 19 subdivision 5 to read as follows:
- 5. A SEX OFFENDER WHO HAS ESTABLISHED RESIDENCE IN THIS STATE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL NOT RESIDE WITHIN FIVE HUNDRED FEET OF A BUILDING USED EXCLUSIVELY AS A SCHOOL, THE MEASUREMENTS TO BE TAKEN IN STRAIGHT LINES FROM THE CENTER OF THE NEAREST ENTRANCE OF THE RESIDENCE TO THE CENTER OF THE NEAREST ENTRANCE OF SUCH SCHOOL.
- 25 S 4. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-26 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
