AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to assaulting a retired police officer

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 120.10 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 5 to read as follows:
- 5. WITH INTENT TO CAUSE SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY, HE OR SHE INTENTIONALLY SELECTS A RETIRED POLICE OFFICER, AS POLICE OFFICER IS DEFINED
  PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION THIRTY-FOUR OF SECTION 1.20 OF THE CRIMINAL
  PROCEDURE LAW, AGAINST WHOM THE OFFENSE IS COMMITTED OR INTENDED TO BE
  COMMITTED IN WHOLE OR IN SUBSTANTIAL PART BECAUSE OF A BELIEF OR PERCEPTION REGARDING SUCH RETIRED POLICE OFFICER'S INVOLVEMENT IN A PREVIOUS
  ARREST OF SUCH PERSON WHILE ON ACTIVE DUTY.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 11 have become a law.
