AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to disregarding certain payments required to be made by a board of cooperative educational services from the calculation of total spending for the purposes of adopting contingency budgets

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph (vii) of paragraph b of subdivision 4 of
2 section 2023 of the education law, as added by section 1 of part D-2 of
3 chapter 57 of the laws of 2007, is amended to read as follows:
4 (vii) expenditures for payments to charter schools pursuant to section
5 twenty-eight hundred fifty-six of this chapter[.]; AND
6 S 2. Subparagraph (vii) of paragraph b of subdivision 4 of section
7 2023 of the education law, as added by chapter 422 of the laws of 2007,
8 is amended and a new subparagraph (ix) is added to read as follows:
9 [(vii)] (VIII) expenditures for self-supporting programs. For purposes
10 of this subparagraph, "self-supporting programs" shall mean any programs
11 that are entirely funded by private funds that cover all the costs of
12 the program[.]; AND
13 (IX) THE AMOUNT ALLOCATED TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH
14 G OF SUBDIVISION FIVE OF SECTION NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY OF THIS TITLE
15 FOR, ANY PAYMENT BY A BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES TO THE
16 DORMITORY AUTHORITY OR ANY PAYMENT REQUIRED BY A BOARD OF COOPERATIVE
17 EDUCATIONAL SERVICES TO ACQUIRE OR CONSTRUCT A SCHOOL FACILITY OF THE
18 BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, AND ANY PAYMENTS FOR RENTAL
19 OF FACILITIES BY A BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES.
20 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
