AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to commencement of a special proceeding

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph 1 of subdivision (b) of section 506 of the civil practice law and rules is amended to read as follows:

- 3 1. a proceeding against a justice of the supreme court [or], a judge of a county court, A JUDGE OF A FAMILY COURT, A JUDGE OF THE COURT OF CLAIMS or [the court of general sessions] A JUDGE OF A SURROGATE'S COURT shall be commenced in the appellate division in the judicial department 7 where the action, in the course of which the matter sought to be enforced or restrained originated, 8 is triable, unless a term of the appellate division in that department is not in session, in which case 9 the proceeding may be commenced in the appellate division in an adjoin-10 ing judicial department; and
- 11 12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to all 13 proceedings commenced on or after such effective date.
