AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to farm waste net
energy metering

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The opening paragraph of paragraph (e) of subdivision 1 of
2 section 66-j of the public service law, as amended by chapter 480 of the
3 laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:
4 "Farm waste electric generating equipment" means equipment that gener-
5 ates electric energy from biogas produced by the anaerobic digestion of
6 agricultural waste, such as livestock manure, farming wastes and food
7 processing wastes with a rated capacity of not more than [five hundred]
8 ONE THOUSAND kilowatts, that is:
9 S 2. Section 66-j of the public service law is amended by adding a new
10 subdivision 2-a to read as follows:
11 2-A. ENVIRONMENTAL ATTRIBUTES. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF
12 LAW, A CUSTOMER-GENERATOR OPERATING FARM WASTE ELECTRIC GENERATION
13 EQUIPMENT SHALL HAVE ALL OWNERSHIP OF ANY ENVIRONMENTAL ATTRIBUTES ASSO-
14 CIATED WITH SUCH FARM WASTE ELECTRICAL GENERATION EQUIPMENT UNLESS SUCH
15 ATTRIBUTES ARE SPECIFICALLY GRANTED BY THE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR TO ANY
16 OTHER PARTY.
17 S 3. Subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (c) of subdivision 3 of section
18 66-j of the public service law, as amended by chapter 452 of the laws of
19 2008, is amended to read as follows:
20 (ii) In the case of a customer-generator who owns or operates farm
21 waste electric generating equipment located and used at his or her "farm
22 operation," up to a total amount of [five] THREE thousand dollars per
23 "farm operation".
24 S 4. Subdivision 4 of section 66-j of the public service law is
25 amended by adding a new paragraph (e) to read as follows:

1 (E) FOR PURPOSES OF PARAGRAPH (B) OF THIS SUBDIVISION, ELECTRICITY USE
2 ELIGIBLE FOR CREDIT OFFSETS SHALL INCLUDE ALL ELECTRICITY USE FROM ALL
3 GRID CONNECTIONS ASSOCIATED WITH A FARM OPERATION.
4 S 5. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
5 have become a law.
