AN ACT in relation to exempting certain ambulance services from the payment of tolls

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the payment of tolls on any highway, bridge, tunnel or other toll road within the state shall not apply to an ambulance service as defined in subdivision two of section three thousand one of the public health law or a voluntary ambulance service as defined in subdivision three of such section, regardless of whether or not such vehicles are responding to an emergency.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
