Introduced by M. of A. MAISEL -- read once and referred to the Committee on Agriculture

AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to requiring approval of the commissioner of agriculture and markets for the compromise of any fine or penalty relating to kosher violations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 201-d of the agriculture and markets law is amended
2 by adding a new closing paragraph to read as follows:
3 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, NO CHARGE OR PENALTY,
4 CIVIL OR CRIMINAL, FOR VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION TWO
5 HUNDRED ONE-A, TWO HUNDRED ONE-B, TWO HUNDRED ONE-C, TWO HUNDRED ONE-E
6 OR TWO HUNDRED ONE-F OF THIS ARTICLE, SHALL BE COMPROMISED OR REDUCED
7 WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSIONER OR HIS OR HER DULY AUTHORIZED
8 DESIGNEE.
9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
10 have become a law.
