AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting issuers from accepting personal information of holders from a third-party

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 518-b to read as follows:
- 3 S 518-B. PROHIBITED CREDIT CARD USER INFORMATION REQUESTS. 1. ISSUERS 4 OF CREDIT CARDS AND DEBIT CARDS ARE PROHIBITED FROM KNOWINGLY ACCEPTING 5 OR SOLICITING THE PERSONAL INFORMATION OF A HOLDER FROM A THIRD-PARTY.
- 6 2. A VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION BY AN ISSUER SHALL BE 7 PUNISHABLE BY A CIVIL PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR 8 EACH SUCH VIOLATION.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of September next 10 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
