AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to providing defendants the ability to call any telephone number located in the United States, its territories and outlying areas for the purpose of obtaining counsel and informing a relative or friend that they have been charged with a crime

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 3 of section 170.10 of the
2 criminal procedure law is amended to read as follows:
3 (b) To communicate, free of charge, by letter or by telephone TO A
4 PHONE NUMBER LOCATED IN THE UNITED STATES, ITS TERRITORIES AND OUTLYING
5 AREAS, for the purposes of obtaining counsel and informing a relative or

7 S 2. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 3 of section 180.10 of the criminal
8 procedure law is amended to read as follows:
9 (b) To communicate, free of charge, by letter or by telephone TO A
10 PHONE NUMBER LOCATED IN THE UNITED STATES, ITS TERRITORIES AND OUTLYING
11 AREAS, for the purpose of obtaining counsel and informing a relative or
12 friend that he has been charged with an offense; and
13 S 3. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 2 of section 210.15 of the criminal
14 procedure law is amended to read as follows:
15 (b) To communicate, free of charge, by letter or by telephone TO A
16 PHONE NUMBER LOCATED IN THE UNITED STATES, ITS TERRITORIES AND OUTLYING
17 AREAS, for the purposes of obtaining counsel and informing a relative or
18 friend that he has been charged with an offense; and
19 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
