AN ACT to direct the commissioner of mental retardation and developmental disabilities to study and report upon the cost to the state for the early diagnosis and long-term treatment of autism spectrum disorder

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The commissioner of mental retardation and developmental
2 disabilities shall cause a study to be performed on the costs to the
3 state for the early diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder and the long-
4 term treatment of individuals with autism spectrum disorder. Such study
5 shall include, but not be limited to, a projected estimate of future
6 cost to the state associated with state services that will be needed to
7 accommodate the growth in the number of individuals being diagnosed with
8 autism spectrum disorder.
9 S 2. On or before April 1, 2011, the commissioner of mental retarda-
10 tion and developmental disabilities shall deliver a copy of the findings
11 of the study conducted pursuant to section one of this act and any

2 governor, the temporary president of the senate, the speaker of the
