AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting the
sale and use of wheel weights containing lead or mercury

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section
2 391-q to read as follows:
3 S 391-Q. LEAD OR MERCURY WHEEL WEIGHT; PROHIBITED. 1. ON AND AFTER
4 JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN ANY PERSON REPLACING OR BALANCING A
5 TIRE ON A MOTOR VEHICLE REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER ARTICLE FOURTEEN
6 OF TITLE FOUR OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW, SHALL NOT USE A WHEEL
7 WEIGHT OR OTHER PRODUCT FOR BALANCING MOTOR VEHICLE WHEELS IF THE WEIGHT
8 OR OTHER BALANCING PRODUCT CONTAINS LEAD OR MERCURY THAT WAS INTEN-
9 TIONALLY ADDED DURING THE MANUFACTURE OF THE PRODUCT.
10 2. ON AND AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN, A PERSON SHALL NOT
11 SELL OR OFFER TO SELL OR DISTRIBUTE WEIGHTS OR OTHER PRODUCTS FOR
12 BALANCING MOTOR VEHICLE WHEELS IF THE WEIGHT OR OTHER BALANCING PRODUCT
13 CONTAINS LEAD OR MERCURY THAT WAS INTENTIONALLY ADDED DURING THE MANU-
14 FACTURE OF THE PRODUCT.
15 3. ON AND AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TWELVE, A PERSON MAY NOT
16 SELL A NEW MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS EQUIPPED WITH A WEIGHT OR OTHER PRODUCT
17 FOR BALANCING MOTOR VEHICLE WHEELS IF THE WEIGHT OR OTHER BALANCING
18 PRODUCT CONTAINS LEAD OR MERCURY THAT WAS INTENTIONALLY ADDED DURING THE
19 MANUFACTURE OF THE PRODUCT.
20 4. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING TERMS SHALL HAVE THE
21 FOLLOWING MEANINGS:
22 A. "LEAD OR MERCURY WHEEL WEIGHT" MEANS ANY EXTERNALLY AFFIXED OR
23 ATTACHED WHEEL WEIGHT USED FOR BALANCING MOTOR VEHICLE WHEELS AND
24 COMPOSED OF GREATER THAN 0.1 PERCENT LEAD OR MERCURY BY WEIGHT.

1 B. "NEW MOTOR VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS REQUIRED TO BE
2 REGISTERED UNDER ARTICLE FOURTEEN OF TITLE FOUR OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAF-
3 FIC LAW THAT HAS NOT BEEN PREVIOUSLY SOLD TO ANY PERSON EXCEPT A
4 DISTRIBUTOR, WHOLESALER OR MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER FOR RESALE.

5 C. "PERSON" MEANS ANY INDIVIDUAL, FIRM, ASSOCIATION, PARTNERSHIP,
6 CORPORATION, ORGANIZATION, OR JOINT VENTURE.

7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
