AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to providing for a priority call system for use in connection with emergency disconnections of utilities, service coverage and oversight of response time in connection with the emergency disconnection of utilities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The public service law is amended by adding a new section 1 2 48-a to read as follows: 3 48-A. PRIORITY CALL SYSTEM AND REPORTING. 1. THE COMMISSION SHALL S 4 ESTABLISH A PRIORITY CALL SYSTEM FOR USE BY POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS 5 IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY REQUIRING DISCONNECTION OF AND AGENCIES 6 UTILITY SERVICES PROVIDED BY A CORPORATION SUBJECT TO THIS ARTICLE. SUCH 7 SYSTEM SHALL BE IN OPERATION AT ALL TIMES, AND SHALL PROVIDE ACCESS ΤO ONE OR MORE EMPLOYEES OF A CORPORATION, WHICH EMPLOYEES SHALL BE AUTHOR-8 IZED TO DIRECT THE IMMEDIATE DISCONNECTION. 9 THE COMMISSION SHALL 10 PROMULGATE SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS AS IT DEEMS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION. 11 12 2. EACH CORPORATION SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL

13 ESTABLISH A PRIORITY CALL SYSTEM, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES AND REGU-14 LATIONS OF THE COMMISSION, FOR USE BY POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS AND 15 AGENCIES IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY REQUIRING DISCONNECTION OF 16 SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE CORPORATION.

17 3. EACH CORPORATION SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL ANNUALLY FILE WITH THE COMMISSION A REPORT, IN SUCH FORM AS THE COMMIS-18 19 SHALL PRESCRIBE, DETAILING THE DATES AND CIRCUMSTANCES OF EACH SION REQUESTED EMERGENCY DISCONNECTION, THE IDENTITY OF 20 THEPERSON, AGENCY AND DEPARTMENT MAKING THE REQUEST, THE RESPONSE TO EACH SUCH REQUEST AND 21 22 TIME REQUIRED TO ACCOMPLISH THE DISCONNECTION OF SERVICE, TOGETHER THE 23 WITH SUCH OTHER INFORMATION THE COMMISSION DEEMS RELEVANT. FAILURE ΤO

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1 COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL RESULT IN A PENAL-2 TY, PAYABLE TO THE COMMISSION, OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS PER DAY UNTIL 3 SUCH TIME AS THE COMPLETED REPORT IS FILED.

4 S 2. Section 65 of the public service law is amended by adding a new 5 subdivision 12 to read as follows:

12. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, IN ORDER TO ENSURE
ADEQUATE SERVICE, EACH CORPORATION SUBJECT TO THIS ARTICLE SHALL ASSIGN,
AT A MINIMUM, ONE SERVICE PERSON FOR EVERY TWENTY THOUSAND PEOPLE IN THE
POPULATION IN EACH LOCAL AREA SERVED BY THE CORPORATION.

10 S 3. Section 66 of the public service law is amended by adding a new 11 subdivision 29 to read as follows:

12 29. THE COMMISSION SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO REOUIRE EACH CORPORATION SUBJECT TO THIS ARTICLE, INCLUDING ELECTRIC CORPORATIONS AND GAS CORPO-13 14 RATIONS, TO MAINTAIN RECORDS OF AND FILE REPORTS REGARDING THE CORPO-15 RATION'S RESPONSE TIMES IN CONNECTION WITH THE DISCONNECTION OF SERVICE 16 PROVIDED BY THE CORPORATION DURING EMERGENCY SITUATIONS AND DURING EMER-17 GENCY AND/OR DISASTER PREPAREDNESS DRILLS CONDUCTED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO POLICE 18 19 AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS, AND TO CONDUCT AUDITS WITH REGARD THERETO. THE COMMISSION SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO EXAMINE THE 20 ACCOUNTS, BOOKS, 21 CONTRACTS, RECORDS, DOCUMENTS AND PAPERS OF ANY SUCH CORPORATION REGARD-ING THE RESPONSE TIME, TO DIRECT THE CORPORATION TO IMPLEMENT ANY RECOM-22 MENDATIONS THE COMMISSION FINDS TO BE NECESSARY AND REASONABLE, AND TO 23 24 IMPOSE FINES FOR THE FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATIONS. 25 s 4. Section 80 of the public service law is amended by adding a new 26 subdivision 13 to read as follows:

13. THE COMMISSION SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO REQUIRE EACH CORPORATION 27 28 SUBJECT TO THIS ARTICLE TO MAINTAIN RECORDS OF THE FILE REPORTS REGARD-29 ING SUCH CORPORATION'S RESPONSE TIMES IN CONNECTION WITH THE DISCON-SERVICE PROVIDED BY THE CORPORATION DURING EMERGENCY SITU-30 NECTION OF ATIONS AND DURING EMERGENCY AND/OR DISASTER 31 PREPAREDNESS DRILLS 32 CONDUCTED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS, AND TO CONDUCT 33 AUDITS WITH REGARD THERETO. THE COMMISSION SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO EXAMINE THE 34 ACCOUNTS, BOOKS, CONTRACTS, RECORDS, DOCUMENTS AND PAPERS OF ANY 35 SUCH CORPORATION REGARDING THE RESPONSE TIME, TO DIRECT SUCH CORPORATIONS TO 36 37 IMPLEMENT ANY RECOMMENDATIONS THE COMMISSION FINDS TO BE NECESSARY AND 38 REASONABLE, AND TO IMPOSE FINES FOR THE FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE COMMIS-39 SION'S RECOMMENDATIONS.

40 S 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
