Introduced by M. of A. V. LOPEZ -- read once and referred to the Committee on Social Services

AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to distribution of federal bonus awards relative to food stamp programs to local social services districts

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 95 of the social services law is amended by adding a new subdivision 12 to read as follows:
- (A) ANY INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS OF LAW NOTWITHSTANDING, IN THE EVENT THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT GRANTS A BONUS BECAUSE OF SOCIAL PERFORMANCE RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF FOOD STAMP BENEFITS, THE OFFICE OF TEMPORARY AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE SHALL DISTRIBUTE BONUS AS FOLLOWS:
- THEOFFICE OF TEMPORARY AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE MAY RETAIN OR PLACE LIMITATIONS ON THE USE OF FIVE PERCENT OF THE ENTIRE BONUS. 9 OFFICE OF TEMPORARY AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE MAY RETAIN, OR PLACE LIMI-10 THE USE OF AN ADDITIONAL PORTION OF THE ENTIRE BONUS, 11 TATIONS ON PROVIDED THAT THE OFFICE OF TEMPORARY AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE 12 THIS ADDITIONAL RETAINED OR LIMITED PORTION IN 13 DETERMINE THE USE OF CONSULTATION WITH THE LOCAL SOCIAL SERVICES DISTRICTS. 14
- (II) ANY PORTION OF THE BONUS THAT IS NOT RETAINED OR LIMITED 15 16 BY THE OFFICE OF TEMPORARY AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO SUBPAR-AGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO LOCAL SOCIAL 17 18 SERVICES DISTRICTS IN PROPORTION TO THEIR CONTRIBUTION TOWARDS ACQUIRING THE BONUS AS DETERMINED BY THE OFFICE OF TEMPORARY AND 19 20 ASSISTANCE.
- FUNDS DISTRIBUTED PURSUANT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF PARAGRAPH (A) 21 (B) 22 OF THIS SUBDIVISION MAY BE EXPENDED BY THE LOCAL SOCIAL 23 DISTRICT FOR ANY FOOD AND NUTRITION PURPOSE CONSISTENT WITH ITS AUTHORI-24 TY UNDER LAW.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 25
