AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law and the state finance law, in relation to a mandatory surcharge for traffic offenses and infractions in Suffolk and Nassau counties

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new
2 section 1809-f to read as follows:
3 S 1809-F. MANDATORY SURCHARGE REQUIRED FOR TRAFFIC OFFENSES AND
4 INFRACTIONS IN SUFFOLK AND NASSAU COUNTIES. 1. WHENEVER PROCEEDINGS THAT
5 ARE ADJUDICATED IN A COURT OR IN AN ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL IN THE COUN-
6 TIES OF SUFFOLK OR NASSAU RESULT IN A CONVICTION FOR A CRIME UNDER THIS
7 CHAPTER OR A TRAFFIC INFRACTION UNDER THIS CHAPTER, OR A LOCAL LAW,
8 ORDINANCE, RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER, THERE
9 SHALL BE LEVIED A MANDATORY SURCHARGE, IN ADDITION TO ANY SENTENCE OR
10 SURCHARGE REQUIRED OR PERMITTED BY LAW, IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY DOLLARS.
11 2. THE ADDITIONAL SURCHARGES PROVIDED FOR IN SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS
12 SECTION SHALL BE PAID TO THE CLERK OF THE COURT OR ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBU-
13 NAL THAT RENDERED THE CONVICTION. WITHIN THE FIRST TEN DAYS OF THE MONTH
14 FOLLOWING COLLECTION OF SUCH SURCHARGES, THE COLLECTING AUTHORITY SHALL
15 PAY SUCH MONEY TO THE STATE COMPTROLLER TO BE DEPOSITED IN THE LONG
16 ISLAND EXPRESSWAY AND SUNRISE HIGHWAY PATROL FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION
17 NINETY-SEVEN-JJJJ OF THE STATE FINANCE LAW.
18 3. THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION FOUR-A OF SECTION FIVE HUNDRED TEN,
19 SUBDIVISION THREE OF SECTION FIVE HUNDRED FOURTEEN AND SUBDIVISION THREE
20 OF SECTION TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN OF THIS CHAPTER GOVERNING ACTIONS

2 CABLE TO THE ADDITIONAL SURCHARGE IMPOSED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.

3 S 2. The state finance law is amended by adding a new section 97-jjjj
4 to read as follows:

5 S 97-JJJJ. LONG ISLAND EXPRESSWAY AND SUNRISE HIGHWAY PATROL FUND. 1.
6 THERE IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED IN THE CUSTODY OF THE COMPTROLLER, A SPECIAL
7 FUND TO BE KNOWN AS THE "LONG ISLAND EXPRESSWAY AND SUNRISE HIGHWAY
8 PATROL FUND".

9 2. SUCH FUND SHALL CONSIST OF ALL MONIES RECEIVED BY THE STATE PURSU-
10 ANT TO SECTION EIGHTEEN HUNDRED NINE-F OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW
11 AND ALL OTHER GRANTS, BEQUESTS OR OTHER MONIES APPROPRIATED, CREDITED OR
12 TRANSFERRED THERETO FROM ANY OTHER FUND OR SOURCE PURSUANT TO LAW.

13 3. MONIES IN THE LONG ISLAND EXPRESSWAY AND SUNRISE HIGHWAY PATROL
14 FUND SHALL BE KEPT SEPARATE AND APART AND SHALL NOT BE COMMINGLED WITH
15 ANY OTHER MONIES IN THE CUSTODY OF THE COMPTROLLER AND SHALL ONLY BE
16 EXPENDED HEREIN AND IN SUCH AMOUNTS AS REQUESTED BY ELIGIBLE MUNICI-
17 PALITIES AND AS APPROVED BY THE STATE COMPTROLLER. MUNICIPALITIES SHALL
18 ONLY BE ELIGIBLE FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF FUNDS EQUIVALENT TO SUCH MUNICI-
19 PALITY'S DEPOSITS INTO THE LONG ISLAND EXPRESSWAY AND SUNRISE HIGHWAY
20 PATROL FUND.

21 4. THE MONIES RECEIVED BY SUCH FUND SHALL ONLY BE ALLOCATED TO OFFSET
22 THE COSTS OF MAINTAINING PATROL ON THE LONG ISLAND EXPRESSWAY AND
23 SUNRISE HIGHWAY BY THE NASSAU COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO OFFSET THE
24 COSTS OF RESTORING PATROL ON THE LONG ISLAND EXPRESSWAY AND SUNRISE
25 HIGHWAY BY THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT. ANY TOWN OR VILLAGE
26 POLICE DEPARTMENT SHALL PATROL WHERE THEY PREVIOUSLY, OR CURRENTLY
27 PATROL ON THE LONG ISLAND EXPRESSWAY AND SUNRISE HIGHWAY. REIMBURSEMENT
28 FOR SUCH PATROLS SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO COUNTY, TOWN, AND VILLAGE
29 POLICE DEPARTMENTS.

30 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
