CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY

proposing amendments to section 2 of article 3 of the constitution, in
relation to the membership of the senate and assembly

1 Section 1. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That section 2 of article
2 3 of the constitution be amended to read as follows:
3 S 2. The senate shall consist of [fifty] FORTY members, except as
4 hereinafter provided. The senators elected in the year one thousand
5 eight hundred and ninety-five shall hold their offices for three years,
6 and their successors shall be chosen for two years. The assembly shall
7 consist of one hundred [and fifty] members. The assembly members elected
8 in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, and their
9 successors, shall be chosen for two years.
10 S 2. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That the foregoing amendment be
11 referred to the first regular legislative session convening after the
12 next succeeding general election of members of the assembly, and, in
13 conformity with section 1 of article 19 of the constitution, be
14 published for 3 months previous to the time of such election.
