AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requiring one number plate on the rear of each motor vehicle

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 402 of the vehi-2 cle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 109 of the laws of 2005, is 3 amended to read as follows:

4 (a) No person shall operate, drive or park a motor vehicle on the 5 public highways of this state unless such vehicle shall have a distinc-6 tive number assigned to it by the commissioner and a [set of] number 7 [plates] PLATE issued by the commissioner with a number and other iden-8 tification matter if any, corresponding to that of the certificate of 9 registration conspicuously displayed[, one] on the [front and one on the] rear of such vehicle, [each] EXCEPT IN CASE OF A TRACTOR WHEN 10 SUCH NUMBER PLATE SHALL BE DISPLAYED ON THE FRONT OF THE VEHICLE AND NONE 11 12 SHALL BE DISPLAYED ON ITS REAR, securely fastened so as to prevent the 13 same from swinging and placed, whenever reasonably possible, not higher 14 than forty-eight inches and not lower than twelve inches from the ground[; provided, however, that in any registration year for which only 15 number plate is issued, such number plate shall constitute a set of 16 one 17 number plates for the time in which such use is authorized, shall be displayed on the rear of the vehicle and none shall be displayed on its 18 19 front, except in case of a tractor, when such number plate shall be 20 displayed on the front of the vehicle and none shall be displayed on its 21 rear].

22 S 2. Subdivisions 2 and 3 of section 404-a of the vehicle and traffic 23 law, subdivision 2 as amended by chapter 191 of the laws of 1991 and 24 subdivision 3 as added by chapter 601 of the laws of 1987, are amended 25 to read as follows:

26 2. Registration of vehicles owned by severely disabled persons. The 27 commissioner shall assign to such motor vehicles, including any van or

pick-up truck used for transporting persons with disabilities which is 1 2 not used for commercial purposes, owned by such persons, a distinctive 3 number and issue and deliver in such manner as the commissioner may 4 select to the owner a certification of registration, in such form as the 5 commissioner shall prescribe and two number plates, called disabled person plates. Said disabled person plates shall conform to the require-6 7 ments of section four hundred one of this [chapter] ARTICLE, but shall 8 bear distinctive marks to distinguish them from number plates to be issued to other persons, qualifying under this chapter. [The commission-9 10 er, in his discretion, may issue, for any registration year, only one 11 plate as a set for a motor vehicle, in which event a set of disabled person plates for a motor vehicle shall consist of one plate.] Where a 12 severely disabled person owns more than one vehicle and such vehicle or 13 14 vehicles is or are used by severely disabled members of the owner's family who reside with the owner, the commissioner shall issue one set 15 of plates for each additional vehicle used by such severely disabled 16 17 person, provided that such user qualifies as a severely disabled person

18 in the manner required by this section. 19 3. Registration of vehicles owned by severely disabled veterans. The 20 commissioner shall assign to such motor vehicles, including any vans or 21 pick-up trucks used for transporting handicapped veterans which are not 22 used for commercial purposes and which are owned by such veterans or a 23 not-for-profit corporation serving such veterans, a distinctive number 24 and issue and deliver in such manner as the commissioner may prescribe 25 to the owner a certification of registration, in such form as the commissioner shall prescribe and two number plates, called disabled veteran plates. Said severely disabled veteran plates shall conform to 26 27 requirements of section four hundred one of this [chapter] ARTICLE, 28 the 29 but shall bear distinctive marks to distinguish them from number plates be issued to other persons, qualifying under this chapter. [The 30 to commissioner in his discretion, may issue, for any registration year, only one plate as a set for a motor vehicle, in which event a set of 31 32 33 severely disabled veteran plates for a motor vehicle shall consist of 34 one plate.] Where a severely disabled veteran owns more than one vehicle and such vehicle or vehicles is or are used by severely disabled members 35 the owner's family who reside with the owner, the commissioner shall 36 of 37 issue one set of plates for each additional vehicle used by such severe-38 ly disabled veteran, provided that such user qualifies as a severely disabled veteran in the manner required by this section. For purposes of 39 40 subdivision, the term "severely disabled veteran" shall mean any this member of the armed forces of the United States who served in time of 41 as defined in section eighty-five of the civil service law, and 42 war, 43 whose disability qualifies him as a severely disabled person within the 44 meaning of such term as defined in subdivision four of this section.

45 S 3. Subdivision 1 of section 404-j of the vehicle and traffic law, as 46 separately amended by chapters 182 and 277 of the laws of 1991, is 47 amended to read as follows:

48 1. Registration of vehicles owned by veterans who survived the Pearl 49 Harbor attack. The commissioner shall assign to motor vehicles, owned by 50 persons who while on military duty serving in the armed forces of the 51 United States survived the Pearl Harbor attack by Japan on December seventh, nineteen hundred forty-one or the spouse of such a person, a 52 distinctive number and issue and deliver in such manner as the commis-53 54 sioner may select to the owner a certification of registration, in such 55 form as the commissioner shall prescribe and two number plates, called Pearl Harbor attack veterans plates. Said plates shall conform to the 56

requirements of section four hundred one of this [chapter] ARTICLE, 1 but 2 shall bear the distinctive words PEARL HARBOR SURVIVOR to distinguish 3 them from number plates to be issued to other persons, qualifying under 4 this chapter. [The commissioner, in his discretion, may issue, for any registration year, only one plate as a set for a motor vehicle, in which 5 6 event a set of plates for a motor vehicle shall consist of one plate.] 7 a distinctive plate set is issued to a Pearl Harbor attack veteran Ιf 8 pursuant to this section, such a distinctive plate set shall not be 9 issued to the spouse of such veteran.

10 S 4. Subdivision 4 of section 415 of the vehicle and traffic law, as 11 amended by chapter 7 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as follows:

4. Number plates. A dealer or other person, qualifying for limited use of motor vehicles, motorcycles or trailers under subdivisions two and 12 13 14 three of this section, shall be entitled to receive one or more sets of 15 number plates for display thereon as the commissioner may determine, upon payment of the required fee for each set. Number plates issued to 16 17 dealers under this section shall bear distinctive marks to distinguish them from transporter plates to be issued to other persons qualifying 18 19 under this section. [A set of number plates shall consist of two plates 20 in the case of a motor vehicle and one plate in the case of a motorcycle 21 or trailer; provided, however, that the commissioner, in his discretion, 22 issue, for any registration year, only one number as a set for a may 23 motor vehicle, in which event a set of number plates for a motor vehicle 24 shall consist of one plate.]

25 S 5. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new section 26 131-b to read as follows:

27 S 131-B. SET OF NUMBER PLATES OR TWO NUMBER PLATES. SET OF NUMBER 28 PLATES OR TWO NUMBER PLATES MEANS ONE NUMBER PLATE PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH 29 (A) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION FOUR HUNDRED TWO OF THIS CHAPTER.

30 S 6. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 31 it shall have become a law; provided that the commissioner of motor 32 vehicles is authorized and directed to promulgate, amend and/or repeal 33 any rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this 34 act on its effective date on or before such date.
