Introduced by M. of A. GUNTHER, JAFFEE, ZEBROWSKI, GALEF, SKARTADOS, RABBITT, CALHOUN, MOLINARO -- read once and referred to the Committee on Corporations, Authorities and Commissions

AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to granting each of the representatives of the counties of Dutchess, Putnam, Orange and Rockland on the metropolitan transportation authority a vote

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subparagraph 1 of paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 1263 of the public authorities law, as amended by section 3 of part H of chapter 25 of the laws of 2009, is amended to read as follows:

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(1) There is hereby created the "metropolitan transportation ty." The authority shall be a body corporate and politic constituting a public benefit corporation. The authority shall consist of a chairman, sixteen other voting members, and two non-voting and four alternate non-voting members, as described in subparagraph two of this paragraph appointed by the governor by and with the advice and consent of the senate. Any member appointed to a term commencing on or after June thirtieth, two thousand nine shall have experience in one or more of the following areas: transportation, public administration, business management, finance, accounting, law, engineering, land use, urban regional planning, management of large capital projects, labor relations, or have experience in some other area of activity central to the mission of the authority. Four of the sixteen voting members other than the chairman shall be appointed on the written recommendation of the mayor of the city of New York; and each of seven other voting members other than the chairman shall be appointed after selection from a written list of three recommendations from the chief executive officer of the county in which the particular member is required to reside pursuant to the provisions of this subdivision. Of the members appointed recommendation of the chief executive officer of a county, one such member shall be, at the time of appointment, a resident of the county of Nassau, one a resident of the county of Suffolk, one a resident of the county of Westchester, one a resident of the county of Dutchess, one a

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resident of the county of Orange, one a resident of the county of Putnam and one a resident of the county of Rockland, provided that the term of 3 member who is a resident of a county that has withdrawn from the metropolitan commuter transportation district pursuant to section twelve 5 hundred seventy-nine-b of this article shall terminate upon the effec-6 tive date of such county's withdrawal from such district. Of 7 voting members, other than the chairman, appointed by the governor with-8 out recommendation from any other person, three shall be, at the time of appointment, residents of the city of New York and two shall be, at the 9 10 time of appointment, residents of such city or of any of the aforementioned counties in the metropolitan commuter transportation district. 11 12 The chairman and each of the members shall be appointed for a term of six years, provided however, that the chairman first appointed shall 13 14 serve for a term ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-one, 15 provided that thirty days after the effective date of the chapter of the 16 laws of two thousand nine which amended this subparagraph, the term of the chairman shall expire; provided, further, that such chairman may 17 18 continue to discharge the duties of his or her office until the position 19 of chairman is filled by appointment by the governor upon the advice and 20 consent of the senate and the term of such new chairman shall terminate 21 June thirtieth, two thousand fifteen. The sixteen other members first 22 appointed shall serve for the following terms: The members from the counties of Nassau and Westchester shall each serve for a term ending 23 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-five; the members from the coun-24 25 from the counties of Dutchess, Orange, Putnam and Suffolk and 26 Rockland shall each serve for a term ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred ninety-two; two of the members appointed on recommendation of 27 the mayor of the city of New York shall each serve for a term ending 28 29 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-four and, two shall each serve 30 for a term ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-one; two of the members appointed by the governor without the recommendation of any 31 32 other person shall each serve for a term ending June thirtieth, nineteen 33 hundred eighty-two, two shall each serve for a term ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty and one shall serve for a term ending June 34 35 thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-five. The two non-voting and four 36 alternate non-voting members shall serve until January first, two thou-37 sand one. [The members from the counties of Dutchess, Orange, Putnam and 38 Rockland shall cast one collective vote.] 39

- S 2. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 1263 of the public authorities law, as amended by section 4 of part H of chapter 25 of the laws of 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- (a) There is hereby created the "metropolitan transportation ty." The authority shall be a body corporate and politic constituting a public benefit corporation. The authority shall consist of a and sixteen other members appointed by the governor by and with the advice and consent of the senate. Any member appointed to a term after June thirtieth, two thousand nine shall have commencing on or experience in one or more of the following areas of expertise: portation, public administration, business management, finance, accounting, law, engineering, land use, urban and regional planning, management large capital projects, labor relations, or have experience in some other area of activity central to the mission of the authority. Four of sixteen members other than the chairman shall be appointed on the written recommendation of the mayor of the city of New York; and each of seven other members other than the chairman shall be appointed after selection from a written list of three recommendations from the chief

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executive officer of the county in which the particular member is required to reside pursuant to the provisions of this subdivision. Of 3 the members appointed on recommendation of the chief executive officer county, one such member shall be, at the time of appointment, a 5 resident of the county of Nassau; one a resident of the county of 6 one a resident of the county of Westchester; [and] one a resi-Suffolk; 7 dent of the county of Dutchess[,]; one a resident of the county 8 Orange[,]; one a resident of the county of Putnam; and one a resident of county of Rockland, provided that the term of any member who is a 9 10 resident of a county that has withdrawn from the metropolitan 11 section district pursuant to twelve hundred seventy-nine-b of this article shall terminate upon the effective date 12 such county's withdrawal from such district. Of the five members, 13 14 other than the chairman, appointed by the governor without recommenda-15 tion from any other person, three shall be, at the time of appointment, residents of the city of New York and two shall be, at the time of 16 17 appointment, residents of such city or of any of the aforementioned the metropolitan commuter transportation district. 18 counties in 19 chairman and each of the members shall be appointed for a term of six 20 years, provided however, that the chairman first appointed shall 21 for a term ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-one, provided 22 that thirty days after the effective date of the chapter of the laws of two thousand nine which amended this paragraph, the term of the chairman 23 expire; provided, further, that such chairman may continue to 24 25 discharge the duties of his office until the position of chairman is 26 filled by appointment by the governor upon the advice and consent of the 27 senate and the term of such new chairman shall terminate June thirtieth, 28 thousand fifteen. The sixteen other members first appointed shall 29 serve for the following terms: The members from the counties of Nassau 30 and Westchester shall each serve for a term ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-five; the members from the county of Suffolk and 31 32 from the counties of Dutchess, Orange, Putnam and Rockland shall each 33 serve for a term ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred ninety-two; two 34 the members appointed on recommendation of the mayor of the city of 35 New York shall each serve for a term ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-four and, two shall each serve for a term ending June 36 37 thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-one; two of the members appointed by the governor without the recommendation of any other person shall each serve for a term ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-two, two 38 39 40 shall each serve for a term ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred 41 eighty and one shall serve for a term ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-five. [The members from the counties of Dutchess, Orange, 42 43 Putnam and Rockland shall cast one collective vote.] 44

S 3. This act shall take effect immediately, provided that the amendments to subparagraph 1 of paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 1263 of the public authorities law made by section one of this act shall be subject to the expiration and reversion of such paragraph pursuant to section 3 of chapter 549 of the laws of 1994, as amended, when upon such date the provisions of section two of this act shall take effect.
