AN ACT to amend the military law, in relation to active service

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 6 of section 1 of the military law, as amended
2 by chapter 112 of the laws of 1989, is amended to read as follows:
3 6. The terms "active service" and "active duty" shall mean military
4 duty in or with a force of the organized militia (not including the
5 inactive national guard and not including the New York guard when in an
6 inactive status) or in the division of military and naval affairs of the
7 executive department of the state, either in a full time status or in a
8 part-time status, depending upon the conditions under which the duty is
9 performed AND SHALL INCLUDE SERVICE AS A MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL GUARD OR
10 AS A RESERVIST ABSENT FROM HIS OR HER PLACE OF RESIDENCE AND UNDERGOING
11 TRAINING UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE ARMY, AIR FORCE, NAVY, MARINE CORPS
12 OR COAST GUARD, AT A PLACE OTHER THAN THAT OF SUCH PERSON'S RESIDENCE.
13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
