AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to prohibiting price differences for the same service based upon gender

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 20 of section 296 of the executive law, as
2 renumbered by chapter 204 of the laws of 1996, is renumbered subdivision
3 21 and a new subdivision 20 is added to read as follows:
4 20. (A) IT SHALL BE AN UNLAWFUL DISCRIMINATORY PRACTICE FOR ANY
5 PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION TO CHARGE A DIFFERENT FEE OR PRICE FOR THE
6 SAME SERVICE BASED SOLELY UPON THE GENDER OF THE RECIPIENT. NOTHING IN
7 THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT A DIFFERENT PRICE OR FEE
8 FOR SIMILAR SERVICES FOR MEN AND WOMEN IF THE SERVICE IS MORE DIFFICULT
9 OR MORE COSTLY. THIS SUBDIVISION APPLIES ONLY TO SERVICES AND DOES NOT
10 INCLUDE PRODUCTS.
11 (B) ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION FOUND TO HAVE VIOLATED THE
12 PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL PAY A FINE OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS
13 OR AN AMOUNT UP TO THREE TIMES THE ACTUAL DAMAGES AND LEGAL FEES, WHICH-
14 EVER IS GREATER.
15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
