AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to counting of affidavit ballots

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 9-209 of the 2 election law is amended by adding a new subparagraph 3 to read as 3 follows:
- 4 3. IF THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS DETERMINES THAT A PERSON WAS ENTITLED TO VOTE AT SUCH ELECTION, THE BOARD SHALL CAST AND CANVASS SUCH BALLOT IF SUCH BOARD FINDS THAT THE VOTER APPEARED AT A POLLING PLACE IN THE CORRECT COUNTY, REGARDLESS OF THE FACT THAT THE VOTER MAY HAVE APPEARED IN THE INCORRECT ELECTION DISTRICT.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
