## IN SENATE

January 27, 2009

Introduced by Sens. THOMPSON, C. JOHNSON, ONORATO, PARKER, STACHOWSKI -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Investigations and Government Operations

AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to establishing the school uniform tax credit not to exceed two hundred dollars, for all expenses related to the purchase of uniforms required by a school's dress code policy for students in kindergarten through the twelfth grade

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 606 of the tax law is amended by adding a new 2 subsection (qq) to read as follows:
  - (QQ) SCHOOL UNIFORM TAX CREDIT. (1) ALLOWANCE OF CREDIT. A RESIDENT TAXPAYER SHALL BE ALLOWED A CREDIT AGAINST THE TAXES IMPOSED BY THIS ARTICLE, NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS, FOR EXPENSES RELATED TO THE PURCHASE OF SCHOOL UNIFORMS FOR A TAXPAYER'S CHILDREN ATTENDING KINDER-GARTEN THROUGH THE TWELFTH GRADE.
  - (2) SCHOOL. SCHOOL MEANS ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL.
  - (3) SCHOOL UNIFORM. SCHOOL UNIFORM MEANS ALL ARTICLES OF CLOTHING OR FOOTWEAR, WHICH ARE REQUIRED AS PART OF THE SCHOOL'S DRESS CODE POLICY.
- 12 (4) AMOUNT OF CREDIT. A RESIDENT TAXPAYER SHALL BE ALLOWED A CREDIT 13 AGAINST THE TAX IMPOSED BY THIS ARTICLE, NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED 14 DOLLARS, FOR EXPENSES RELATED TO THE PURCHASE OF SCHOOL UNIFORMS.
  - S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
