AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to allowing wine labels to contain information regarding antioxidants

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a
2 new section 86 to read as follows:

3 S 86. WINE BOTTLE LABELS; ANTIOXIDANTS. A WINERY MAY INCLUDE ON THE
4 LABEL OF A WINE BOTTLE, A STATEMENT STATING THAT THE WINE CONTAINS ANTI-
5 OXIDANTS, PROVIDED THAT THE WINE BOTTLE BEARING SUCH LABEL IS NOT SOLD,
6 OFFERED FOR SALE, SHIPPED, DELIVERED FOR SHIPMENT OR OTHERWISE INTRO-
7 DUCED INTO COMMERCE OUTSIDE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK.

8 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
