AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to marijuana themed candy

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 399-i to read as follows:
- S 399-I. MARIJUANA THEMED CANDY. 1. NO CANDY OR CONFECTION SOLD IN THIS STATE SHALL BE PACKAGED, SHAPED OR MANUFACTURED TO RESEMBLE MARI-JUANA OR MARIJUANA PRODUCTS OR TO IMITATE THE FLAVOR OF MARIJUANA.
- 6 2. A VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE PUNISHABLE 7 BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS OR A TERM OF IMPRISON-8 MENT OF UP TO ONE YEAR, OR BOTH SUCH FINE AND IMPRISONMENT.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-10 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
