AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to counting of affidavit ballots

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subparagraph 3 of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 2 9-209 of the election law, as added by chapter 248 of the laws of 2009, 3 is amended to read as follows:
  - 3. If the board of elections determines that a person was entitled to vote at such election, the board shall cast and canvass such ballot if such board finds that the voter appeared at [the correct] A polling place IN THE CORRECT COUNTY, regardless of the fact that the voter may have appeared in the incorrect election district.
    - S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
