- AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to actions by health care providers against patients

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The insurance law is amended by adding a new section 3224-c 2 to read as follows:
- S 3224-C. ACTIONS 3 BY HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS RELATED ΤO INSURANCE ACTION BROUGHT A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER AGAINST A 4 CLAIMS. IN ANY ΒY 5 PATIENT TO RECOVER PAYMENT FOR AN OUTSTANDING BILL, FOR SERVICES SHALL BE AN AFFIRMATIVE 6 RENDERED BY SUCH HEALTH CARE PROVIDER, IΤ 7 DEFENSE TO SUCH ACTION THAT THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER FAILED TO SUBMIT 8 THE INSURANCE CLAIM TO THE PATIENT'S INSURER IN A TIMELY MANNER.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 10 have become a law, and shall apply to civil actions brought on or after 11 such effective date.
