Introduced by Sens. MORAHAN, DeFRANCISCO, DIAZ, FUSCHILLO, GOLDEN, MAZIARZ, RANZENHOFER, SEWARD, SKELOS, VOLKER -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Finance

AN ACT relating to authorizing and directing the commissioner of general services to erect a suitable marked monument in honor of Persian Gulf War veterans; and making an appropriation therefor

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The commissioner of general services is hereby authorized
2 and directed to erect a suitable marked monument in the Governor Nelson
3 A. Rockefeller Empire State Plaza or Capitol Park, in the city of Alba-
4 ny, dedicated to the memory and honor of all New York residents who
5 served in the armed forces of the United States during the Persian Gulf
6 War which shall include those who have served in the theater of oper-
7 ations in Iraq and Afghanistan.
8 S 2. The sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), or so much
9 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the office of
10 general services from any moneys in the state treasury in the general
11 fund to the credit of the state purposes account not otherwise appropri-
12 ated for services and expenses of the office of general services for the
13 purposes of carrying out the provisions of this act. Such sum shall be
14 payable on the audit and warrant of the state comptroller on vouchers
15 certified or approved by the commissioner of general services, or his or
16 her duly designated representative in the manner provided by law. No
17 expenditure shall be made from this appropriation until a certificate of
18 approval of availability shall have been issued by the director of the
19 budget and filed with the state comptroller and a copy filed with the
20 chair of the senate finance committee and the chair of the assembly ways
21 and means committee. Such certificate may be amended from time to time
22 by the director of the budget and a copy of each such amendment shall be
23 filed with the state comptroller, the chair of the senate finance
24 committee and the chair of the assembly ways and means committee.
25 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
