AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring the disclosure of the market for which a vehicle was manufactured

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 198-b of the general business law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision h to read as follows:

H. DISCLOSURE OF INTENDED MARKET. A DEALER MUST DISCLOSE IN WRITING TO
THE CONSUMER WHETHER THE VEHICLE BEING PURCHASED BY THE CONSUMER WAS
MANUFACTURED FOR INTRODUCTION INTO THE AMERICAN MARKETPLACE, OR WHETHER
SUCH VEHICLE WAS MANUFACTURED FOR INTRODUCTION INTO A FOREIGN MARKETPLACE.

8 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
