AN ACT to amend the general obligations law, in relation to declaring agreements indemnifying or exempting manufacturers, sellers, and/or monitors of burglary protection systems from liability for negligence void and unenforceable

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The general obligations law is amended by adding a new 2 section 5-326.1 to read as follows:
- 3 AGREEMENTS INDEMNIFYING OR EXEMPTING MANUFACTURERS, SELL-S 5-326.1. ERS, AND/OR MONITORS OF BURGLARY PROTECTION SYSTEMS FROM LIABILITY 5 NEGLIGENCE VOID AND UNENFORCEABLE. 1. EVERY COVENANT, AGREEMENT OR 6 UNDERSTANDING IN OR IN CONNECTION WITH OR COLLATERAL TO ANY CONTRACT 7 ENTERED INTO WITH THE MANUFACTURER, SELLER AND/OR MONITOR OF A BURGLARY PROTECTION SYSTEM RELATIVE TO THE SALE, INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE AND/OR 8 MONITORING OF A BURGLARY PROTECTION SYSTEM EXEMPTING FROM LIABILITY OR 9 10 LIMITING THE LIABILITY OF SUCH MANUFACTURER, SELLER AND/OR MONITOR OR 11 PURPORTING TO INDEMNIFY OR HOLD HARMLESS SUCH MANUFACTURER, 12 AND/OR MONITOR AGAINST LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE ARISING OUT OF BODILY INJURY PERSONS OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY CAUSED BY OR RESULTING FROM THE SOLE 13 NEGLIGENCE OF SUCH MANUFACTURER, SELLER AND/OR MONITOR, HIS 14 AGENTS OR 15 TO AN AMOUNT WHICH IS LESS THAN THE COST ASSOCIATED WITH THE INSTALLATION, SERVICE AND MAINTENANCE PROVIDED BY THE MANUFACTURER, 16 17 SELLER AND/OR MONITOR IS AGAINST PUBLIC POLICY AND IS VOID AND UNEN-FORCEABLE. 18
- 2. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A "MONITOR" OF A BURGLARY PROTECTION SYSTEM IS ANY PERSON, FIRM, ORGANIZATION, CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION OR OTHER ENTITY WHICH, FOR COMPENSATION, RECEIVES SIGNALS FROM A BURGLARY PROTECTION SYSTEM AND TRANSMITS NOTIFICATION TO THE

POLICE, OR OTHER AUTHORITIES AND/OR SUCH OTHER PERSONS AS ARE SET FORTH IN THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE MONITOR AND THE CONSUMER.

3 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 4 have become a law and the provisions of section 5-326.1 of the general 5 obligations law, as added by section one of this act, shall apply only 6 to contracts entered into on or after such date.
