AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to certain requirements for renewing a driver's license

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 6 of section 502 of the vehi-2 cle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 81 of the laws of 1995, is 3 amended to read as follows:

4 (a) A license issued pursuant to subdivision five of this section 5 shall be valid until the expiration date contained thereon, unless such 6 license is suspended, revoked or cancelled. Such license may be renewed 7 submission of an application for renewal, the fee prescribed by law, by 8 proofs of prior licensing, fitness and acceptable vision prescribed by 9 the commissioner, [the applicant's social security number,] and if required by the commissioner a photo image of the applicant in such 10 numbers and form as the commissioner shall prescribe. AN APPLICANT FOR 11 12 RENEWAL SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE HIS OR HER SOCIAL SECURITY 13 SHOW A SOCIAL SECURITY CARD EVEN IF SUCH NUMBER OR CARD WAS NUMBER OR NOT PROVIDED TO THE DEPARTMENT IN A PREVIOUS TRANSACTION. In addition, 14 applicant for renewal of a license containing a hazardous material 15 an endorsement shall pass an examination to retain such endorsement. A 16 17 renewal of such license shall be issued by the commissioner upon 18 approval of such application, except that no such license shall be issuance would be inconsistent with the provisions of 19 issued if its 20 section five hundred sixteen of this [chapter] TITLE, and except that the commissioner may refuse to renew such license if the applicant is 21 the holder of a currently valid or renewable license to drive issued by 22 23 another state or foreign country unless the applicant surrenders such 24 license.
