AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to authorizing
distinctive license plates for members of Kiwanis International

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new
2 section 404-x to read as follows:
3 S 404-X. DISTINCTIVE PLATES FOR MEMBERS OF KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL. 1.
4 ANY MEMBER OF KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL RESIDING IN THIS STATE SHALL, UPON
5 REQUEST, BE ISSUED A DISTINCTIVE LICENSE PLATE BEARING THE OFFICIAL LOGO
6 OF KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL AND THE WORDS "KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL".
7 2. APPLICATION FOR SUCH LICENSE PLATE SHALL BE FILED WITH THE COMMIS-
8 SIONER IN SUCH FORM AND DETAIL AS THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PRESCRIBE.
9 3. THE DISTINCTIVE PLATE AUTHORIZED IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE ISSUED
10 UPON PROOF, SATISFACTORY TO THE COMMISSIONER, THAT THE APPLICANT IS A
11 MEMBER OF KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL.
12 4. A DISTINCTIVE PLATE ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE ISSUED
13 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER NUMBER PLATES UPON PAYMENT OF THE REGULAR
14 REGISTRATION FEE PRESCRIBED BY SECTION FOUR HUNDRED ONE OF THIS ARTICLE,
15 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT AN ADDITIONAL ANNUAL SERVICE CHARGE OF
16 TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS SHALL BE CHARGED FOR SUCH PLATE. SUCH ANNUAL
17 SERVICE CHARGE SHALL BE DEPOSITED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION
18 FOUR HUNDRED FOUR-00 OF THIS ARTICLE, TO THE CREDIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
19 MOTOR VEHICLES DISTINCTIVE PLATE DEVELOPMENT FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION
20 NINETY-FIVE-G OF THE STATE FINANCE LAW, AND SHALL BE USED FOR THE
21 PRODUCTION, DESIGN, ADVERTISING AND MARKETING OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE
22 PLATES PURSUANT TO SUCH SECTION NINETY-FIVE-G.
23 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after
24 it shall have become a law.
